

# Downtown Ventura Partners Board Meeting Minutes, May 22, 2013

### I. Call to Order & Introductions:

President David Armstrong called the meeting to order at 8:35am.

## **II.** Approval of April DVP Minutes:

**a.** DVP April minutes approved. Motion made by Mark Hartley, seconded by Ed Warren. Passed unanimously.

# **III. Approval of April DVP Financials:**

### **IV. DVP Action Items:**

- **a.** Approved repayment in full (\$3,607.35) of truck loan. Motion made by Jeff Smith, seconded by Cheryl Heitmann. Passed unanimously.
- **b.** Approved \$30,000 in unrestricted funds to purchase a trolley, and to send a request letter to the City for matching funds in the same amount. Trolley purchase is contingent upon obtaining matching funds and prior signed funding agreements within \$500 of total monthly operating expenses. Motion made by Jeff Smith, seconded by Ed Warren. Passed unanimously. Doug Wood abstained.
- **c.** Authorized Executive Director to enter into financing and advertising agreements with various partners to pay for trolley operating costs. Motion made by Jeff Smith, seconded by Cheryl Heitmann. Passed unanimously.
